Within 3 months prior to the expiration of the agreement, however, pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 552a(o)(2)(D) the Data Integrity Boards (DIB) may, without additional review, renew the CMA for a current, ongoing matching program for a period not more than one additional year, if: (1) such program will be conducted without any change; and (2) each party to the CMA certifies to the DIB(s) in writing that the program has been conducted in compliance with the CMA.
