

RENEWAL OF THE COMPUTER MATCHING AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION
AND
THE DEFENSE MANPOWER DATA CENTER OF
THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE

Under the provisions of the Computer Matching and Privacy Protection Act of 1988, Public Law No. 100-503, that amended the Privacy Act of 1974, as amended, 5 USC §552a, a computer matching agreement shall remain in effect for such period, not to exceed 18 months, as the Data Integrity Boards of the participating agencies determine is appropriate. However, the Data Integrity Boards may renew the agreement for a period, not to exceed one additional year, if: (1) such program will be conducted without change; and (2) each party to the agreement certifies to the boards in writing that the program has been conducted in compliance with the agreement.

This computer match will be conducted without any substantive changes. However, the following non-substantive changes have occurred:
