

**RECERTIFICATION AND RENEWAL OF THE COMPUTER MATCHING
AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION
AND
THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE**

DoD Match #88

Under the applicable provisions of the Privacy Act of 1974, as amended by the Computer Matching and Privacy Protection Act of 1988, 5 U.S.C. § 552a(o)(2), a computer matching agreement will remain in effect for a period not to exceed 18 months. Within 3 months prior to the expiration of such computer matching agreement, however, the Agencies may, without additional review, renew the computer matching agreement for a current, ongoing matching program for a period not to exceed one additional year if:

1. such program will be conducted without any changes; and
2. each party to the agreement certifies to the Data Integrity Board (DIB) in writing that the program has been conducted in compliance with the agreement.

The following match meets the conditions for renewal by this recertification:

I. TITLE OF MATCH:

Computer Matching Agreement (SSA Match #1004, DoD Match #88)

II. PARTIES TO THE MATCH:

Recipient Agency: Department of Defense (DoD), Defense Manpower Data Center (DMDC)

Source Agency: Social Security Administration (SSA)

III. PURPOSE OF THE AGREEMENT:

This computer matching agreement establishes the terms, conditions, and safeguards under which DoD DMDC will conduct computer matching with SSA to verify information provided to SSA by recipients, and applicants thereof, of Supplemental Security Income (SSI) payments and beneficiaries of Special Veterans Benefits (SVB) benefits, and applicants thereof. The SSI and SVB recipient/beneficiary provides information about eligibility/entitlement factors and other relevant information. SSA obtains additional information as necessary before making any determinations of eligibility/payment or entitlement/benefit amounts or adjustments thereto. With respect to military retirement payments to SSI recipients and SVB beneficiaries who are retired members of the Uniformed Services or their survivors, SSA will accomplish this task by

computer matching with DoD/DMDC. DoD/DMDC will match the information provided by SSA against the DoD DMDC database, which contains extracts of personnel and pay records of retired members of the Uniformed Services or their survivors.




