# RENEWAL OF THE COMPUTER MATCHING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION AND THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE DEFENSE MANPOWER DATA CENTER

# SSA Match #1004 DoD Match #88

Under the applicable provisions of the Privacy Act of 1974, amended by the Computer Matching and Privacy Protection Act of 1988, 5 U.S.C. § 552a(o)(2), a computer matching agreement (CMA) will remain in effect for a period not to exceed 18 months. Within 3 months prior to the expiration of such a CMA, however, the Data Integrity Board (DIB) may, without additional review, renew the CMA for a current, ongoing matching program for a period not to exceed one additional year if:

- 1. such program will be conducted without any changes; and
- 2. each party to the CMA certifies to the DIB in writing that the program has been conducted in compliance with the CMA.

A copy of the CMA to be renewed is attached hereto.

The following match meets the conditions for renewal upon signature of the officials authorized in sections VII and VIII of this renewal for the Social Security Administration (SSA) and the Department of Defense (DoD), Defense Manpower Data Center (DMDC).

#### III. PURPOSE OF THE AGREEMENT

This computer matching agreement (agreement) sets forth the terms, conditions, and safeguards under which the Department of Defense (DoD), Defense Manpower Data Center (DMDC) (DoD/DMDC) will disclose military retirement payment data to the Social Security Administration (SSA). SSA will use the military retirement payment and

survivor benefit payment data to verify information provided by applicants, recipients, deemors, and beneficiaries of Supplemental Security Income (SSI) payments and Special Veterans Benefits (SVB). The SSI and SVB applicants, recipients, deemors (i.e., someone other than the eligible individual or eligible spouse whose income and resources are considered when determining an individual's eligibility for SSI and the amount of his or her payment), and beneficiaries provide information about eligibility and entitlement factors (e.g., income, resources, living arrangements). SSA obtains additional information, as necessary, before making any determinations of eligibility, payments, entitlement or benefit amounts or adjustments thereto. Military retirement payments to SSI and SVB applicants, recipients, deemors, and beneficiaries include retired members, or their survivors, of the Uniformed Services, i.e., Army; Navy; Air Force; Marine Corps; Coast Guard; Space Force; and Commissioned Corps of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (but not including the Commissioned Corps of the U.S. Public Health Service).
